SOCCER 2020 Terms 2 and 3



Soccer starts early in Term 2 and we need definitive numbers to enter teams in the Eastern Zone Primary Schools Soccer Association Competition. Matches are played at various local pitches on Saturday mornings. Students aged 7 years and under are unable to play in the competitive games but may join the Development Squad (train one night a week) if volunteers are available to run this. We offer the following teams:

- 1. Development Squad (Born 2013 and after), boys and girls.
- 2. 8 years (Born 2012), boys and girls.
- 3. 9 years (Born 2011), boys and girls.
- 4. 10 years (Born 2010), boys and girls.
- 5. 11 years (Born 2009), boys and girls.
- 6. Boys or Girls Senior teams (Year 6 or 7).

In the past, when there have not been enough players nominating for an age group, we have combined the age groups and submitted one team in the older age group, with parental permission. For example, if we have 4 players for the 9 year old team and 7 players for the 10 year old team, we have nominated a team for the 10 year old age group. Can you please indicate on the nomination form, whether you agree for your child to play in the age group above, should this happen this season.

Note: Soccer season runs over Terms 2 and 3 so students and parents/guardians must commit to playing the entire season. Training times and days will be organised once teams and coaches have been finalised.

ESTIMATE of FEES

This is a <u>quide</u> only for your information and is subject to change, NO MONEY TO BE PAID AT THIS STAGE.

Association Fees: \$130 (Inc GST) per team, for the 8 year olds age group, and \$350 (Inc GST) per team for 9, 10 year olds and \$400 for 11 year old and senior teams, these fees are for the entire season and include the referee levy. The **fee per child** depends on the number of participants, but as a guide, it would be between \$15 - \$50 (Inc GST) depending on age of child and number of players in the team.

Training fee: Approx. \$11.00 (Inc GST) to be paid to the front office in a sealed envelope stating your child's name, class and team.

Uniform: \$25.00 (CASH) refundable deposit is to be paid by each member of the team to the front office. This is to be placed in a clearly named envelope (stating your child's name, class, team manager and team).

Development squad fee: No cost at this stage.

Sports Administration fee: \$40.00 (Inc GST) must also be paid if your child plays any after school sports for Vale Park Primary School. This covers the associated costs of running After School Sports at Vale Park Primary. This is a once off, annual fee.

Note: Parents must attend training with their child, if the child is to attend OHSC on the night of training, then arrangements must be made with OSHC.

COACHING/VOLUNTEERING

The school would also appreciate it if parents/caregivers of the children interested in playing soccer for the school consider volunteering for coaching or managing a team. If you are able to help out, please fill in the Parent Assistance Form below. It is expected that parents assist in scoring at the games.

All volunteer coaches, managers/supervisors must have a current DCSI clearance or a Working With Children Check (WWCC) and be trained in Responding to Abuse and Neglect (RAN training) as per Department for Education and Vale Park Primary School's sports policy. Vale Park Primary School will pay associated costs for these.

These teams will not be entered into the competition if we do not have the necessary volunteers. Our students appreciate your support!

Once final numbers are established, we will send out a notice to your child confirming their place in a team and the final fees to be paid. The entire fee must be paid to the front office in a sealed envelope stating your child's name, class and team <u>by the due date</u>, as the nomination will only be accepted by the association if full payment is made at the time of registration. If we do not have enough players, or there are no volunteer coaches or Association Fees are not paid by the due date, we will not be able to submit a team.
